



Fall Watering Checklist



Water Deeply & Consistently

Slowly soak or use a soaker hose get moisture down 6–8 inches into the soil, where roots can access it



Prioritize New Plantings

Trees, shrubs, evergreens, and perennials installed this season need more frequent watering.



Don't Overlook Evergreens

Give evergreens a long, slow soak before the ground freezes to prevent browning and winter burn.



Check the Soil, Not the Calendar

Use your finger, a screwdriver, or a soil probe to see if the soil is dry several inches down before watering again.



Remember the Lawn

Fall watering helps repair summer stress damage and helps it green up faster in spring.
