

# **Fall Watering Checklist**



#### Water Deeply & Consistently

Slowly soak or use a soaker hose get moisture down 6–8 inches into the soil, where roots can access it



### **Prioritize New Plantings**

Trees, shrubs, evergreens, and perennials installed this season need more frequent watering.



## **Don't Overlook Evergreens**

Give evergreens a long, slow soak before the ground freezes to prevent browning and winter burn.



#### Check the Soil, Not the Calendar

Use your finger, a screwdriver, or a soil probe to see if the soil is dry several inches down before watering again.



#### Remember the Lawn

Fall watering helps repair summer stress damage and helps it green up faster in spring.
